- 2. (a) How does Homer portray the character of Achilles in Book-I? Discuss his motivations and his response to the conflict with Agamemnon.

- (b) Examine the role of the gods in Book-II, particularly in relation to the dream sent to Agamemnon and the subsequent actions of the Greek and Trojan armies. How do their interventions shape the narratives?

- (b) Do you think that the figure of Oedipus arouses our admiration as well as our sympathy? Give a well-reasoned answer.
- **4.** (a) How does The Pot of Gold exemplify Roman comedy?

- (b) Write an essay on the way Plautus links the themes of love and marriage to the human propensity for trickery and greed.
- 5. (a) Each story in Ovid's Metamorphoses reports a transformation. What transformation takes place in Pyramus and Thisbe?

(b) Ovid's story of Procne, Philomela and Tereus is a horrific tale of rape and revenge. Elaborate.
